Most recently, Setterberg Di Vivo served as General Manager of One&Only The Palm in Dubai, where she was responsible for overseeing and directing 400 employees (across 47 different nationalities), 100 rooms, three restaurants, including a 2 Michelin-starred offering – one of just two in the city, and an award-winning spa.

Setterberg Di Vivo's highly distinguished reputation and phenomenal career trajectory has seen her receive nationally and internationally recognized awards for exceptional accomplishments in the luxury hotel management space. The landmark building is currently being restored as part of a top-to-toe renovation, led by Paris-based interior designer, Tino Zervudachi.
